North Star Improv Comedy Class

This Summer, North Star is planning to offer an Improv Comedy Class. What is Improv Comedy? Comical acting, off the cuff, without a script. Like on that show *Whose Line is it Anyway?*

The most basic component of Improv is taking in what your fellow scene workers (actors) are doing, and then acknowledging, responding to, and building on that. This is a rule of thumb referred to as "Yes, and . . ." For example, if Actor A is portraying a employee of an ice cream parlor filling a cup with raspberry sorbet, Actor B might build on that by jumping into the role of a coworker making a rootbeer float, or the parlor's manager criticizing their employee for overfilling the cup, or perhaps an irate customer airing complaints about receiving a brownie sundae instead of the banana split they ordered.

But why Improv? What's the point? Improv comedy is both a silly and entertaining way to practice many Communication and Executive Functioning skills including:

- Expressing ideas and feelings Nonverbally
 - Processing Nonverbal cues
 - Task Initiation
 - Resilience in the spotlight
 - Flexibility
